How big is photovoltaic power generation in China?

According to data released by the National Energy Administration, the cumulative total installed capacity of photovoltaic power generation in China in 2020 was 253GW, a year-on-year increase of 23.8%. As photovoltaics gradually enter the era of parity and 14-five-year plan, the installed capacity will show a more rapid growth trend.

How big is China's photovoltaic capacity in 2020?

In 2020, China's newly installed grid-connected photovoltaic capacity reached 48.2GW, a year-on-year increase of 60.1%, of which the installed capacity of centralized photovoltaic power plants was 32.7GW, a year-on-year increase of 82.68%; the installed capacity of distributed photovoltaic power plants was 15.5GW, a year-on-year increase of 27.04%.

What is the potential of solar PV in China?

The researchers first found that the physical potential of solar PV, which includes how many solar panels can be installed and how much solar energy they can generate, in China reached 99.2 petawatt-hoursin 2020.

Is China's solar PV potential priced lower than coal-fired energy?

According to our results, approximately 78.6 % and 99.9 % of China's technical solar PV potential are priced lower than the benchmark price of coal-fired energy in pessimistic and optimistic scenario.

What is China's new PV installed capacity?

In the first three quarters of 2020, China's newly added PV installed capacity was 18.7 GW, higher than the level of the same period of last year. In the fourth quarter, it showed explosive growth, making the annual newly added installed capacity reach 48.2 GW, including 32.68 GW of centralized PV and 15.52 GW of distributed PV.

How much does PV cost in China?

The uncertainty of PV technical potential was quantified. The cost of PV ranges from 0.12 CNY/kWh to 7.93 CNY/kWh. China's PV economic potential far exceeds its projected electricity demand. Solar power is vital for China's future energy pathways to achieve the goal of 2060 carbon neutrality.

Researchers from Harvard, Tsinghua University in Beijing, Nankai University in Tianjin and Renmin University of China in Beijing have found that solar energy could provide 43.2% of China's electricity demands in 2060 ...
