How much do solar panels cost?

If you just need a few panels for a small do-it-yourself solar project, expect to pay around \$200 to \$350 per panel (between \$0.80 and \$1.40 per watt). We suggest using NREL's PVWatts Calculator for estimating your solar installation costs. First, consider your average household energy needs. This tells you how big of a system you need.

How much does a home solar system cost?

Home solar systems typically range from \$6 to \$12 per square foot of living space. The actual cost may vary based on the size and electricity consumption. These estimates are assuming the homeowner claims the 30% federal tax credit for the solar system.

Are solar panels worth it?

Solar panels can generate major savings if you're trying to reduce your electricity costs, carbon emissions or both. The primary factor in determining whether or not solar panels are worthwhile for you is the cost you're currently paying for electricity. The higher your electricity costs, the more a solar panel system will save you in the long run.

How much does a 1500 square foot Solar System cost?

The average solar system costs around \$27,500 before incentives, and around \$19,250 after the 30% tax credit for a 1,500 square foot house, according to a data analysis by Solar.com. Do solar panels save you money?

The higher your electricity costs, the more a solar panel system will save you in the long run. This can vary significantly based on your location. If you live in a region with middle- to upper-level utility rates, you can pretty much guarantee that a solar panel will save you big bucks over time.

How much does solar energy cost per watt?

The cost per watt is what you pay for each unit of power of your solar energy system. Think of it a little like "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes. As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84.

How much does one solar panel cost? The average cost for one 400W solar panel is between \$250 and \$360 when it's installed as part of a rooftop solar array. This boils down to \$0.625 to \$0.72 per watt for panels purchased through a full-service solar company.
