



# How to add a charging port to the battery pack

How do you charge a backpack with a USB port?

To charge your battery with a USB port, connect your device's charging cable to the USB port and the other end to your device. Ensure the USB port is connected to a power source, like a power bank or wall outlet. A backpack with a USB charging port is more than just a bag.

How does a USB charging port work?

When you connect your phone or any other device to the external USB port, it draws power from the power source via this internal wiring. The power flows from the power source, through the wires, into your device's battery--allowing it to charge. Most backpacks with USB charging ports don't come with a power bank included.

How do you charge a backpack without a battery?

Most backpacks don't have a built-in battery, so you'll need to provide your own. Once you have a power bank, plug it into the USB port inside your backpack. Then, take the charging cable for your device and plug it into the USB port on the outside of the backpack. Your device should start charging right away.

How do I charge a 5v USB battery?

Insert the other end of the USB cable into an AC adapter and plug it in to a wall socket. The battery is designed to charge 5V USB-charged devices. Plug the micro-USB cable into your battery's charging port. Connect the other end of the cable to your device to begin charging. Disconnect your device when fully charged.

How do you charge a backpack with a power bank?

Once you have a power bank, plug it into the USB port inside your backpack. Then, take the charging cable for your device and plug it into the USB port on the outside of the backpack. Your device should start charging right away. One thing to watch out for is compatibility between your device's charging cable and the backpack's USB port.

Plug the micro-USB cable into your battery's micro-USB port. Insert the other end of the USB cable into an AC adapter and plug it in to a wall socket. The battery is designed to charge 5V USB-charged devices. Plug the micro-USB cable into your battery's charging port. Connect the other end of the cable to your device to begin charging.
