

How to remove the battery board of the volume button

How do you remove a volume button board?

Use the edge of an opening tool to gently pry the volume button board away from the frame. If the volume button board begins to bend significantly, stop and pry from a different angle. Continue prying until you loosen the volume button board from the frame.

How do you remove a volume button from a phone?

Use tweezers or the point of a spudger to pry up and remove the black tape covering the volume buttons on the right edge of the phone. Repeat the process with the black tape covering the power button on the left edge of the phone. Use the edge of an opening tool to gently pry the volume button board away from the frame.

How do I remove a battery from a board?

You need to apply gentle pressure to the battery (as if you are trying to pull it off of the board). Then heat up the solder on each lead of the battery. You can ask someone to help you with this part or just use your fingers to brace against the mainboard as if you're trying to pinch/push the battery away from the board.

How do you remove a battery pack?

Step 1-- Battery Loosen the two screws of the battery panel. Then lift the panel up to remove it. L Button. Top of the battery pack. To remove the battery pack, place your fingernail or a spudger at the top of the battery near the L button. Gently lift. Lower Case Assembly Two screws are hidden underneath two rubber feet

How do you remove a volume button from a tweezer?

Squeeze the tweezer tips together and insert the point underneath the volume button board's contact pad near the top right edge of the frame. Pry upwards to loosen the contact pad from the frame. Remove the volume buttons.

How do you remove a power button from a phone?

If you do tear the tape, replace them with pieces of electrical tape. Use tweezers or the point of a spudger to pry up and remove the black tape covering the volume buttons on the right edge of the phone. Repeat the process with the black tape covering the power button on the left edge of the phone.

Use this guide to replace the volume button in your device. Place your device flat down on a clean surface. Use a Spudger to remove the back cover using the notch at the top left. Use a Spudger to remove the battery using the notch located underneath the battery. Note: During the creation of this guide, we did not have access to a battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.

Remove the single 6.1 mm Phillips #000 screw from underneath the kickstand. Remove the two 2.7 mm Phillips #000 screws from the bottom of the device.

Move the hard drive cable away from the battery. You want to make enough clearance to remove the battery without it catching on the hard drive cable. Step 6.
