

Lithium battery shipping customs declaration

What are the shipping requirements for lithium ion batteries?

In addition, lithium-ion cells and batteries shipped by themselves must be shipped at a state of charge not exceeding 30% of their rated capacity. Lithium batteries are dangerous goods, and all of the regulatory requirements must be complied with, as set out in the Lithium Battery Shipping Regulations.

How do I attach a lithium battery - shipper declaration letter?

Please place the completed Lithium Battery - Shipper Declaration Letter in document pouch or attach it to the outside of the packaging, while the completed Lithium Battery label should be attached directly to the packages. This guide is for illustrative purposes only.

How do I ship lithium batteries internationally?

For shipping Lithium Batteries internationally by air, whether they are packed with equipment or alone, the shipper should complete the Lithium Battery - Shipper Declaration Letter and Battery Label, as described in this user guide.

Do I need a manual to ship lithium batteries?

However, if you only ship lithium batteries you can purchase the Lithium Batteries Shipping Regulationsas a standalone manual. Knowing the specific regulations is crucial in the shipping and handling of lithium batteries.

What are the requirements for a lithium battery label?

The mark must be in the form of a rectangle or a square with minimum dimensions of 100 mm x 100 mm. If the size of the package so requires, the dimensions/line thickness may be reduced to not less than 100 mm wide × 70 mm high. The Lithium Battery label is required for consignments which have a larger number, or more powerful, batteries.

Where can I find the lithium battery marking and labeling guidelines?

You can find the lithium battery marking and labeling guidelines inside Section 7of the latest copy of the Dangerous Goods Regulations (DGR) or the Lithium Battery Shipping Regulations (LBSR).
