Moldova has established a new regulation for approving power plants over 20 MW, streamlining the authorization process for renewable energy projects on the free market without support schemes. The regulation aims to enhance efficiency and transparency, with project evaluations conducted by the Authorization Commission.

The integration of large-scale RES installations in Moldova will require significant changes in the operational practices of the utilities. The grid will need additional flexibility in the generation mix, as well as large-scale battery energy storage and efficient demand-side management tools.

In May of last year, TotalEnergies launched its first battery energy storage project in Belgium. Located at its refinery in the city of Antwerp, the battery project will have a capacity of 75MWh; enough to power around 10,000 homes. Saft is also providing 40 of the same high energy Li-ion containers for this project, which is set to come online by the end of 2024.
