

## New Energy Battery Capacity Query System

What are base year costs for utility-scale battery energy storage systems?

Base year costs for utility-scale battery energy storage systems (BESSs) are based on a bottom-up cost modelusing the data and methodology for utility-scale BESS in (Ramasamy et al.,2023). The bottom-up BESS model accounts for major components, including the LIB pack, the inverter, and the balance of system (BOS) needed for the installation.

Figure 19 demonstrates that batteries can store 2 to 10 timestheir initial primary energy over the course of their lifetime. According to estimates, the comparable numbers for CAES and PHS are 240 and 210, respectively. These numbers are based on 25,000 cycles of conservative cycle life estimations for PHS and CAES.

Are bio-batteries a game changer in the search for green energy?

What is the capacity factor of a battery system?

The cost and performance of the battery systems are based on an assumption of approximately one cycle per day. Therefore, a 4-hour device has an expected capacity factor of 16.7%(4/24 = 0.167), and a 2-hour device has an expected capacity factor of 8.3% (2/24 = 0.083).

How will technology change the supply chain for batteries?

Finally,the growth in the market (effective learning-by-doing) and an increased diversity of chemistries will expand and change the dynamics of the supply chain for batteries, resulting in cheaper inputs to the battery pack (Mann et al., 2022).
