



No current sound when powered by battery

laptop is plugged in but doesn't charge while gaming but this problem occurs only when battery is low, say around 25%. As soon as the battery hits around 40%+ charge the problem resolves, even when gaming there is no problem. Also at low battery level sometimes static sound comes out from speakers along with normal sound.

My laptop is Dell Vostro 1550 purchased online in Nov12. When power cable is connected, sound works fine but when on battery power, no sound even after terminating other applications to rede...

I have tested the battery again with a more accurate meter. With the battery disconnected it is showing 12.58v. When powered up and reconnected to the panel, it remains exactly the same. The output from the 2 battery fly leads (with battery disconnected and power on) is negligible at about 1.7 mV.

I've only been using this laptop for a month. but i found that this laptop suddenly has no sound when the battery is 35% and i have to restart. How do I fix this problem? Hi, I am Sumit here to assist you with this question. Do you have any Power utility from the OEM? I would suggest removing it and see if the issue persists?

3 ???· When I use a USB cord to power my Arduino, the connected piezo buzzer provides a consistent noise. However, when I use a 9V battery to power my Arduino (both using battery jack, and VIN), the buzzer is extremely inconsistent, making the buzzer sound like a geiger counter. Piezo wiring is just a digital pin connected to the + end, and a resistor connected to the - end. ...

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It is likely that on the times that you receive no sound the incorrect sound device has been selected. The next time that you notice the problem, right click on the speaker ...

I'm using an APC BR1500 as a battery backup unit. Whenever I disconnect it from the AC source and it switches to battery mode, my monitor makes a loud buzzing sound, which is similar to the sound coming from the UPS, but louder. I'm assuming this is because when on battery mode, it does not output a pure sine wave, but a "stepped sine wave ...

Fixed the sound issue. To perform a hard reset on a computer with a removable battery, use the following steps: Turn off the computer. Remove the computer from any port ...
