Why is my outdoor solar light not working?

Another reason why your outdoor solar light won't work could be because the battery isn't properly seated in the fixture. Given that most outdoor solar lights are made in Asia and then shipped thousands of miles, it's perfectly possible that the battery would have become dislodged. This is easy to check.

Does an outdoor solar light work?

Strange as it might sound, it's the level of darkness that dictates whether an outdoor solar light works or not. Solar lights rely on a photocell to judge the level of darkness and the level of light. If it's not dark enough (and the switch is on), the light simply won't come on.

How to fix solar lights not working?

Switch your solar light to a different location and see if the problem is fixed. Place it in a location with adequate sunlight during the day and no intervention from other artificial lights at night. So, these were a few common ways to fix Solar lights not working.

Do outdoor solar lights need to be hardwired?

Outdoor solar lights have the advantage of providing free lighting without needing to be hardwired. Despite the simplicity of the design, they do sometimes develop problems. The good news is that most of the problems are easy to troubleshoot and fix. The very first thing to check on your outdoor solar light is the on/off switch.

Why does my solar light need to be taken out?

Solution: To save battery life, when the solar light is shipped, the manufacturer uses a small tab in between the battery and the battery terminal. If your solar light has this tab, it needs to be taken out for the light to illuminate. 5. Is the battery installed correctly? Solution: Be sure the battery or the batteries are installed correctly.

Why are my solar lights not working at night?

During the day, the sensor keeps the solar lights off while the solar panel charges the battery. When night falls, the sensor detects the decrease in light and activates the solar lights. If this sensor is not working correctly, it might not be able to tell when it's dark, and as a result, your solar lights won't turn on at night.
