



# Plug in power turn off battery and vibrate

How do I Stop my Phone from vibrating when charging?

To turn off the vibration you get when you plug your phone in to charge, go to Settings > Sounds & Haptics > System Haptics (it's at the bottom of that screen). If you have not already, it's always a good idea to restart your phone as described in the article below.

If you want to turn off vibration altogether, select Accessibility in your settings menu and tap the slider to turn off vibration.

Why does my phone keep vibrating?

However, if it continues to vibrate beyond that, this may be due to a damaged charger cable or a clogged-up charging port. If your charger cable is partially torn, it may not be providing your phone with a constant flow of current. This causes the phone to continually connect and disconnect from the charger, vibrating every time it does so.

So, I powered off the iPhone by holding down the power button and the upper-volume button, then swiped right at the top of the screen just as I would normally, even though I couldn't actually see anything. I could tell my phone powered off because there were no more vibrations. Then, I powered it back on holding both the power and the increased ...
