



Seiko inverter battery authenticity identification

What is a Seiko serial number?

The serial number has a number of different purposes. Most important, it helps the manufacturer keep track of each and every single watch they produce. But at the same time, the recorded databases of the serial numbers are rarely shared with the public but are used and kept by the company alone. This also includes Seiko.

How to date a Seiko Watch?

The good thing is that you can use the serial number of your Seiko to date it in order to know when it was produced. The format for dating it via the serial number is as follows: The first digit in the number will indicate the last digit of the year the watch was manufactured.

How do I know if a Seiko has a date of manufacture?

The month and last digit of the Seiko's date of manufacture is calculated using the serial number and then narrowed down to a decade using my database of Seiko movement manufacture dates. You will be given an eBay link to check the value, useful links such as manuals, etc and for quartz models the battery information.

How many digits does a Seiko Watch have?

The serial number contains six digits and can also be found on the case back. Each Seiko watch has a serial number that is unique to that exact watch. Furthermore, the case back of a Seiko watch reveals a bunch of different information.

How do I calculate the year of manufacture of a Seiko movement?

You can use the Seiko serial number in conjunction with the movement number to calculate the year of manufacture. The month and last digit of the Seiko's date of manufacture is calculated using the serial number and then narrowed down to a decade using my database of Seiko movement manufacture dates.

Where can I find a Seiko model number?

If you Google the movement and case number you can usually find the unique model number (e.g. SKXS79), although older Seikos usually didn't have one. If you look on JDM auction sites for instance, they often still use the movement and case code (7S26-0480) even when there's a unique model number available (SKXS77, for example). Helpful, thanks.
