Why is my laptop battery not working?

While the cause of laptop battery errors can be rather mysterious, there are a number of ways to work out what the problem is and fix it. Plug in your laptop. It's possible the battery has simply run out of juice, so before you begin panicking, attach it to a power source. Wait for at least 15 minutes, then try turning it on.

How to turn on a laptop if it has a removable battery?

But if your laptop has a removable battery, then you can remove it, put it back, and try to turn your laptop on. This is a general rundown of what the process looks like and some tips. The actual process might differ depending on the model you have - After a few minutes, put the battery back into the laptop and try turning it on again.

User's laptops don't turn on by using the power button due to a number of different reasons but primarily due to hardware problems. The power-on issue is not limited to a particular make, model, or type (internal or removable battery) of laptops.

How do I fix a faulty laptop battery?

If the issue persists, remove the charger and battery from the laptop and press/hold the power button for 1 minute. Then leave the laptop (without battery and charger) in this condition for 24 hours and afterward, press/hold the power button of the laptop for 1 minute. Now reseal the battery and power on the laptop to check if it powers on.

How to reseal a laptop battery?

Remove any external devices or peripherals from the laptop. Then disconnect the laptop from the charger and remove the laptop battery. Now press and hold the power button of the laptop for 1 minute. Then release the power button and connect back the power supply or charger (do not reseal battery or attach any other devices/peripherals).

How do I fix a laptop battery not detected error?

Most modern batteries have automatic shutoffs when they're completely charged. Restart your laptop. This should be one of the first things you try when encountering almost any problem with your laptop (or any device, really), as restarting can fix a lot of issues such as a battery not detected error. Cool down your laptop.
