

The state installs solar energy in China

How much solar energy did China install in 2017?

In the first nine months of 2017, China saw 43 GW of solar energy installed in the first nine months of the year and saw a total of 52.8 GW of solar energy installed for the entire year. 2017 is currently the year with the largest addition of solar energy capacity in China.

How many solar installations are there in China?

According to the National Energy Administration of China, new solar installations reached 216.88 GW last year, representing a year-on-year increase of 148.12%. New solar PV installations amounted to 53 GW for the month of December, increasing by 144.24% year-on-year and representing nearly a quarter of the entire year's solar capacity additions.

Where is solar power generated in China?

Most of China's solar power is generated within its western provinces and is transferred to other regions of the country. In 2011, China owned the largest solar power plant in the world at the time, the Huanghe Hydropower Golmud Solar Park, which had a photovoltaic capacity of 200 MW.

China's National Energy Administration has unveiled that the country's newly added solar PV capacity in the first quarter of 2024 was 45.74 GW, up from 33.66 GW in the same quarter last year. Previous data from the energy administration showed that the newly installed PV capacity in the first two months was 36.72 GW.

Data released by China's National Agency last week revealed that the country's solar electric power generation capacity grew by a staggering 55.2 percent in 2023. The numbers highlight over 216 gigawatts (GW) of solar power China built during the year.
