How do you replace a battery?

Secure the new battery to the bracket and grease the terminals. Place the new battery in the battery tray and secure it to the bracket. Simply reverse the process you used to remove the battery from the bracket. Then, coat each of the terminals in a thin layer of lithium grease to prevent corrosion.

Place the new battery in the tray. Fastening it securely using the same screws and/or clamps. Next apply an anti-corrosion spray on the terminals. This is to prevent rust and corrosion. Reattach the positive cable first. Followed by the negative cable. Ensure the connections are tight and secure.

How do you remove a battery from a car?

If required, you can use a wrench to loosen the cable clamps and detach them safely. Do this gently so as to not damage the components. Unfasten any screws (or clamps) that might be holding the battery securely. Then carefully lift the battery out of the car. If you have a battery carrier use it now. This is a safer way to lift the battery.

How do I fix a bad battery?

Reconnect the positive cable first. Undo the cable tie securing the positive cable to the engine bay, being careful not to touch the end of it to anything metal. Put the cable over the terminal and tighten it down with a wrench. Put the cover over the terminal, if the battery has one.
