How do I set a low battery level?

Scroll down to the "Battery" category. Expand the "Battery" category, and then expand "Low battery level" and "Critical battery level." For both options, set the percentage values to the desired levels. Click on "Apply" and then "OK" to save the changes.

On a Windows 11/10 laptop, you must have seen battery level warnings. These notifications ask Windows users to save the work and shut down the computer or connect the laptop to a power source or change the battery. There are two types of warnings - Reserve Battery and Critical Battery.

How do I set a critical battery level in Windows 10?

A) Type the command below for On battery and/or Plugged in you want to use into the command prompt, and press Enter. Substitute percentage in the commands above with a percentage number between 0 to 100 for the critical battery level you want. The default critical battery level is 5 %.
