



# Which energy storage container power station in Mauritania is the best

Who owns Mauritania's electricity plant?

Completed in 2017, the \$53 million plant is run by the national electricity company, Sociéte Nationale d'Electricité (Sonelec), and has seen ongoing works since its inauguration by (then) President Mohamed Ould Abdel Aziz, removing an estimated 57,000 tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> per annum and supplying 10% of Mauritania's net energy production.

Does Mauritania have a green energy transition?

From zero renewables in 2008 to the 38% electricity mix share it boasts today, Mauritania's green energy transition has come a long way, rapidly accelerating in line with the urgency of the climate crisis.

Could renewable generation capacity improve Mauritania's mining operations?
